PERFORMANCE RESIDENCY

***PLEASE DO NOT DUPLICATE OR DISTRIBUTE THIS SAMPLE**

The Tour Actor/Directors will call you the Tuesday before your residency begins to get the information on the Sponsor Checklist. They will discuss audition/rehearsal schedules and locations with you. It will help tremendously if you have directions to all locations. During the call, they will also set up an in-person contact meeting to walk the space(s) with you prior to auditions.

Here is a **SAMPLE** rehearsal schedule (times are flexible to your needs and can be changed with consultation from Education Office and/or Tour Actor/Directors):

- *Specific characters called and times scheduled may vary in your community.
- *30 minute meal/snack breaks occur mid-way through rehearsals.
- *The Teaching Artists will provide the exact schedule at the audition.

- Cast members called for both rehearsal sessions are asked to bring a sack lunch/dinner for the 30 minute snack/meal break.
- Performances are approximately 45 minutes. Saturday's schedule will vary, but will typically consist of the Full Company arriving 1 hour prior to the performances, with a 1 hour break between. EXAMPLE: Arrive at 1p for 2p performance, 3p BREAK, Arrive at 4p for 5p performance
- Daily starting times are adaptable to fit your specific needs. Please remember that the time allotted for rehearsals is 4 ½ hours each day, so plan your starting time accordingly. Not all children will be called for every rehearsal.
- Along with casting the children who will perform in the show, we will also be looking for older children to run the lights and sound and to be assistant directors.
